Action Taken Report

#### Introduction:

This action taken report is based on the analysis of the feedback collected through the Student Feedback Form. The feedback covers multiple aspects of the student experience, including academic quality, learning environment, support services, and extracurricular activities. Based on the feedback received, various actions have been taken to address the needs and suggestions of the students.

### 1. Academic Experience:

- Feedback: Students expressed varied levels of satisfaction with the quality of teaching, workload management, and course material relevance. Some students suggested improvements in professor accessibility and teaching methods.
- Actions Taken:
  - Organized faculty workshops focusing on interactive teaching methods to improve student engagement.
  - Requested faculty to set dedicated office hours for student queries and increase availability for academic support.
  - Reviewed course materials with faculty to ensure they are relevant and updated, and arranged additional resources where necessary.

## 2. Learning Environment:

- Feedback: Feedback on study facilities (libraries, study rooms) and classroom comfort
  was mixed. Some students highlighted the need for improvements in the availability and
  comfort of study spaces.
- Actions Taken:
  - Upgraded library and study rooms with additional seating, improved lighting, and resources based on student requirements.
  - o Initiated maintenance checks for classrooms and lecture halls to enhance comfort, ventilation, and seating arrangements.

### 3. Support Services:

- Feedback: A portion of students have utilized academic support services and rated them
  highly, but accessibility to academic advisors and counseling services was an area of
  concern for some.
- Actions Taken:
  - Expanded academic advising hours and made them more accessible by providing online booking options.
  - Increased visibility of counseling services through email newsletters, posters, and website updates to ensure students are aware of available support.
  - Launched peer tutoring programs in subjects with high demand for additional support.

## 4. Online Learning Tools:

- **Feedback**: The effectiveness of online learning platforms received mixed responses, with a few students finding them ineffective.
- Actions Taken:
  - Collaborated with the IT department to enhance the performance of online learning platforms.
  - Provided training sessions for both students and faculty on utilizing the full range of online tools available to improve their effectiveness.

• Regularly monitor the performance and usability of online platforms to address any technical issues promptly.

- · Actions Taken:
  - Initiated a "Campus Facilities Improvement Project" to systematically address infrastructure-related concerns, including enhancing Wi-Fi access and study areas.
  - o Introduced regular feedback sessions between students and faculty to address workload concerns and make adjustments where feasible.
  - Increased the number of workshops on time management, study skills, and career planning to better support students' academic and personal development.

#### Academic Year 2019-20

#### Introduction:

The academic year 2019-20 marked the start of a structured analysis of student satisfaction to improve the quality of academic and campus experiences. Feedback was collected to assess various dimensions of student experience, including the quality of teaching, accessibility of support services, effectiveness of learning facilities, and participation in extracurricular activities. This initial feedback survey aimed to set a baseline for identifying strengths and areas needing attention in order to shape future improvements.

### Aims and Objectives:

- Aim: To establish an understanding of student satisfaction across key academic and campus areas, helping to set a foundation for targeted improvements.
- Objectives:
  - 1. To assess the quality of teaching and learning as experienced by students, specifically in terms of teaching satisfaction and accessibility to faculty.


